

## The Corporate Discipline of Worship

- *“To worship is to quicken the conscience by the holiness of God, to feed the mind with the truth of God, to purge the imagination by the beauty of God, to open the heart to the love of God, to devote the will to the purpose of God.” — William Temple*
- **Isaiah 6:1-8 & Ezekiel 1:25-28**
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ (glory) of God

- **1 Corinthians 14:13-19**
  - You should not ask the question, \_\_\_\_\_, but instead, “What kind of worshiper is God seeking? What kind of worship does he call for?”
- **Acts 16:16-26**—an example of the \_\_\_\_\_ (Hebrews 13:15)
- Seven tips to make worship more *real*
  - Practice the \_\_\_\_\_ daily
  - Worship in many different settings
  - Be fully \_\_\_\_\_ for corporate worship
  - Be willing to witness and participate in the power of the Lord
  - Become dependent on God for the worship experience, \_\_\_\_\_
  - Don’t dwell on distractions, accept them
  - Learn to offer the “sacrifice of worship”
- *“If worship does not propel us into greater obedience, it has not been worship. To stand before the Holy One of eternity is to change.” (Foster)*
